**“Burning Question”** (God Calls Moses)

Aim's - - - Students Should Know That:

1. The Israelites were in slavery, God heard their cries and called Moses from a burning bush; and he was attentive to God's call.
2. Moses was asked to take off his shoes in the presence of God (Holy Ground); and we need to be respectful and have the proper attitude of humility, reverence and praise when in church.
3. God knew of their oppression in Egypt, was going to take them out of slavery, and bring them to the promise land.
4. Like Moses, we might feel inadequate when called by God to do something; however, we are not alone and God is present with us with His authority and power.

**Discussion Topics:**

- How does God feel about oppression; and does he hear the prayers of the oppressed?
- Moses went from being a Prince to becoming a Shepherd. Do we have to be humbled before we can be useful to God?
- How can we be more attentive in listening to God's call to us?
